#### **Key Objectives**

- Strengthen the political leadership of young Venezuelan exiles, promoting their participation in the international debate on democracy and human rights.
- Defend their political rights in exile, by advocating for mechanisms of protection and international recognition.
- Build narratives for a democratic Venezuela, through spaces for dialogue and reflection on their experiences and proposals.
- Raise awareness of the political and social situation of exiles, by organizing an international forum that brings together key political and social actors.
- Promote international resolutions that encourage the respect and protection of the political rights of young Venezuelans in exile.

## **Program**



**Duration:** 2 months

**Objective:** To gather the stories and perspectives of young Venezuelan political exiles, identifying their experiences, challenges, and proposals for a democratic Venezuela.



**Duration:** 1 month

**Objective:** To raise awareness of the political and social situation of young Venezuelans in exile and to foster debate on their rights and prospects for returning under a democratic system.

## Phase 3: Presentation of International Resolutions

**Duration:** 1 month

**Objective:** To advocate for the recognition and defense of the political rights of young exiles through the promotion of international resolutions.



# **Strengthening editorial platforms**

The Venezuela in Democracy Project aims to inspire the consolidation of international youth leadership through the creation of editorial platforms with a regional perspective and an approach independent from political parties. To achieve this, the Mariano Ospina Pérez Foundation will strengthen youth opinion platforms through both physical and digital formats, while also promoting the engagement of young leaders in political, economic, business, and religious spheres.
